## Abuse of Postmasters & Inefficient and Ineffective Post Office Management Practices By Upper Level Managers

**Issue:** The Abusive Treatment Of Postmasters And The Inefficient And Ineffective Post Office Management Practices Of Upper Level USPS Managers.

**League Position:** Congress should exercise its oversight authority and step in and fix this.

**Action Requested:** Write a letter to:  
— Postmaster General Jack Potter  
—Your local Congressman and Senators and cc Mr. Potter on that letter  
—Chairmen Edolphus Towns and Ranking Member Darrell Issa of the House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform and cc the rest of the members.  
—Chairman Stephen Lynch and Ranking Member Jason Chaffetz of the House Subcommittee of the Federal Workforce and Postal Service and cc the rest of the members  
—Chairman Joseph Lieberman and Ranking Member Susan Collins of the Senate Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs

Ask them to investigate this matter and use their oversight authority to correct it. Use your own experience to explain why rural post offices and postmasters are important to rural America. Don't limit your arguments to postal issues. Talk about the role of rural post offices in rural society and in your town.
