

RLP SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM APPLICATION 2010

ONLY THIS 2009 FORM WILL BE ACCEPTED — NO PREVIOUS VERSIONS MAY BE USED TO APPLY FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

THE RETIRED LEAGUE POSTMASTERS of the National League of Postmasters will award scholarships to qualifying students.

QUALIFICATIONS: The applicant must be the child or grandchild of an active Postmaster or a Retired Postmaster, who is a member of the **NATIONAL LEAGUE OF POSTMASTERS.**

- Applicant must be a high school graduate accepted, as a **FIRST YEAR STUDENT**, for fall admission to an accredited college, university or trade school.

- The applicant must have a 3.0 Grade Point Average (GPA) overall or a 3.0 average for the last full year of high school.

- Applicant must provide a transcript of his or her grades covering the most recent year of school. This must be received by the RLP postmarked not later than June 30.

- Applicant must list and briefly describe awards and community service during his or her previous school terms. Applicant will have to provide enough information that the committee will know what he or she was doing during the school term.

- The applicant must provide the committee with A COPY OF HIS OR HER LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE TO THE COLLEGE OF CHOICE. ALSO, HE OR SHE MUST INCLUDE COPIES OF ACT, SAT OR OTHER ENTRANCE

EXAMINATION SCORES AS APPLICABLE.

If they leave school for any reason except for sickness or death, the money must be returned to the Retired League Postmasters.

ADVERTISEMENT AND SELECTION: The scholarships will be advertised in the **POSTMASTERS ADVOCATE** and in state League newsletters.

- Application forms will be sent to each applicant with instructions.
- A committee of five (5) will screen applications, judging on test scores, secondary school records, personal qualifications and community involvement. Decision of the committee will be final. The winners will be announced at the National League of Postmasters National Convention.

APPLICANTS INSTRUCTIONS: A letter covering the qualifications that we have outlined, an application, the name and address of the person to whom all the necessary papers are to be returned to will be sent to each applicant who applies for the scholarship.

NOTIFICATION TO APPLICANT: The president of the **RETIRED LEAGUE POSTMASTERS** will have the responsibility of notifying the honorees of our scholarships, that they are the winners. The National Secretary/Treasurer of the RLP will issue the checks to the academic institutions which the students are attending.
